Two hundred ninth-grade students from the Yonkers Public Schools will embark on their path to college as Yonkers Partners in Education (YPIE) Scholars, a community of students preparing for success in college and beyond.

At this first in-person Induction Ceremony since the pandemic, YPIE will welcome the Scholars Class of 2030, named for the year these students will graduate from college. This class was selected based on their drive, dedication, and focus on their future.

YPIE Scholars participate in rigorous academics and career exploration afterschool at the YPIE College Zone, and work with YPIE staff and volunteer mentors from across the community.

Incoming YPIE Scholars and their families are invited to the Induction Ceremony with partners from the Yonkers Public School District and the local community. During the ceremony, current YPIE Scholars will share their experiences and lead the new Scholars in taking the YPIE Commitment to Excellence oath.
